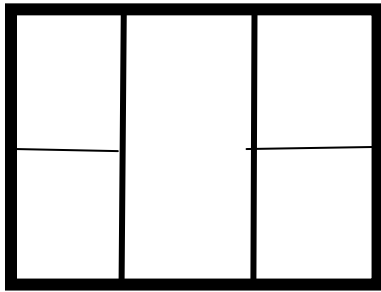
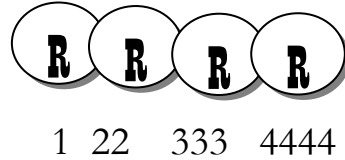
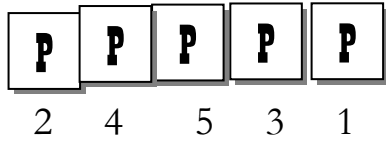


## Stage 1

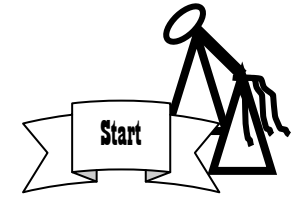
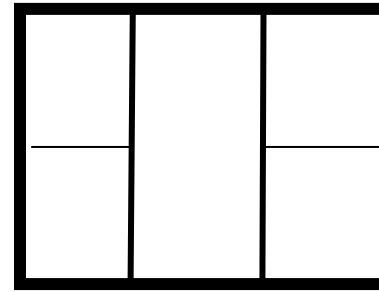
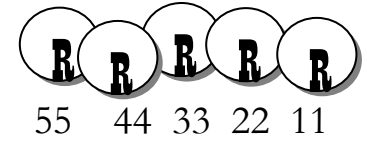
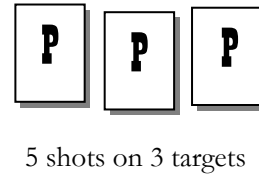


Round Count Pistol: 10

Rifle: 10

Shooter seated with the rifle on the table pointed down range and the pistols holstered, starts with both hands palms down on the table and says "Maybe poker is just not your game,...I know let's have a spelling contest" (from the movie *Tombstone*). At the buzzer the shooter picks up the rifle and while seated engages the 4 rifle targets in a progressive sweep starting from the left [1 22 333 4444]. The shooter then moves to the leftmost window, draws a pistol and engages the 5 pistol targets with an Outside In Sweep from the right two times [2 4 5 3 1]

## Stage 2

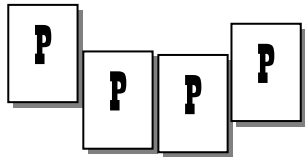


Round Count Pistol: 10

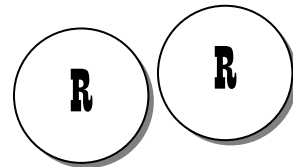
Rifle: 10

Pistols are holstered, rifle in horse's scabbard. Shooter sits on the horse and says "Fill your hands with steel you sons of a bitch" (from the movie *True Grit*). At the buzzer shooter draws the rifle from the scabbard and engages the 5 rifle targets (right side of range) with double tap sweep from the right [55 44 33 22 11]. The shooter then dismounts and moves to the right most window and engages the 3 pistol targets with 5 shots on 3 targets, two times -shooter's choice as to the order but all 3 must be shot at with each pistol.

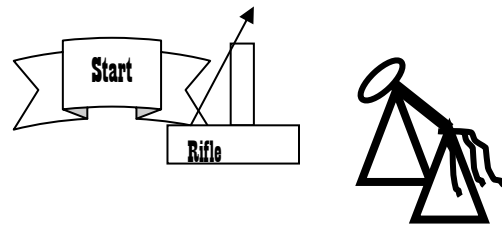
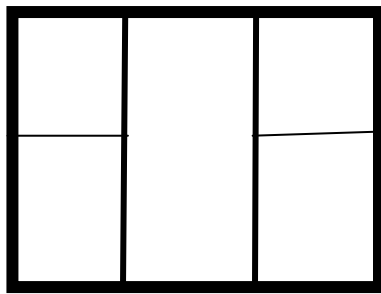
### Stage 3

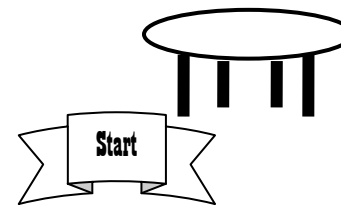
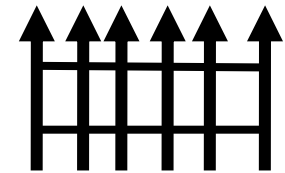
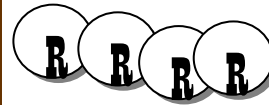

Round Count Pistol: 10 Rifle: 10

With pistols holstered, rifle in rack, horse to the side, shooter says "I'm lookin for the owner of that horse. He's tall, he's blond and he's a pig" (from *The Good the Bad and the Ugly*)  
At the buzzer the shooter picks up the rifle and alternates shots on the 2 rifle targets starting on the right. The shooter places the rifle in the rack and moving to the left engages the 4 pistol targets through the right-most window with a 'Cactus Buck' sweep starting with the leftmost target [111 22 33 444 ]

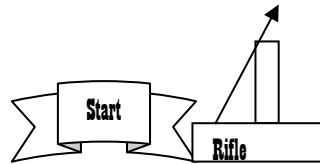
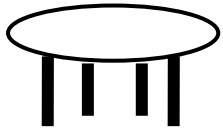
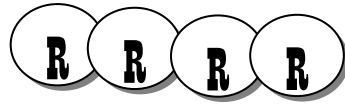
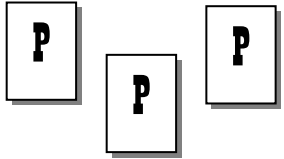
### Stage 4



Round Count Pistol: 10 Rifle: 10

Two pistols holstered, rifle on the table, shooter says " If you pull on me , I'll kill all of you where you stand" (from movie *Appaloosa*) At the buzzer the shooter picks up the rifle and engages the 4 rifle targets with a Nevada sweep starting from either side. The shooter then hands off the rifle and moves to the fence where the 6 pistol targets are engaged with a California sweep —every other shot is at the first target. .

## Stage 5



Round Count     Pistol: 10 Rifle: 10

Both pistols are staged on the table. Shooter starts with the rifle in the rack. When ready shooter shouts **“Hell’s comin and I’m comin with it”** At the buzzer the shooter picks up the rifle and engage the 4 rifle targets with a Nevada sweep starting with the leftmost target. Shooter then places the rifle back in the rack and moves to the table picks up the first pistol engaging the three pistols targets by double tapping each outside target then one in the middle target when finished with the first pistol place it back on the table and repeat with the second pistol

## STAGE CONVENTIONS

These conventions will apply to all shooting stages at the Conestoga Wagoneers shoots. It is the responsibility of each shooter to be familiar with all of these conventions prior to shooting. Any penalties incurred as a result of these conventions will not be grounds for an appeal or re-shoot.

1. All staged guns shall have their barrels pointed safely down range. All rifles that are staged horizontally shall be staged lying flat where at least rear of the trigger guard is on the staging area.
2. Shooters may not start a stage with ammunition in hand.
3. Long guns will be discarded open and empty with their barrels pointed safely down range.
4. Pistols are to be returned to leather after the shooting string, unless otherwise designated in the stage instructions.
5. Pistols are drawn and used in accordance with the shooter’s category.
6. Safe gun handling is the shooter’s responsibility. The 170° safety rule is in effect.
7. If no starting position is given the shooter shall stand fully erect with revolvers holstered, hands at the shooter’s side not touching any firearm.
8. Cowboy port arms is defined as standing fully erect with the butt of the long gun at or below the waist of the shooter, the muzzle at or above the shoulder and the long gun held with both hands.
