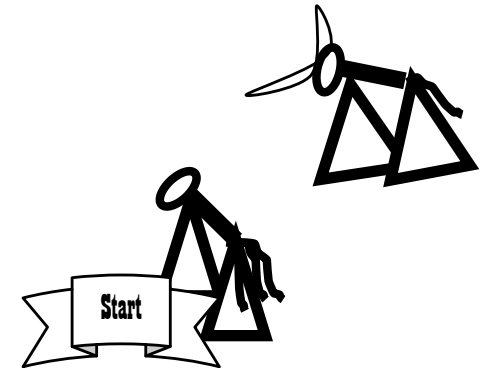
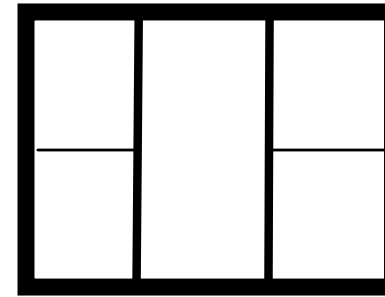
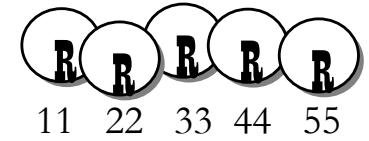
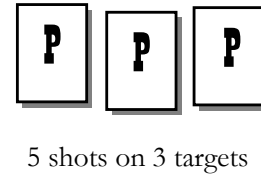
Round Count Pistol: 10

Rifle: 10

BONUS: Trivia question asked.

Shooter seated with the rifle on the table pointed down range and the pistols holstered, starts with both hands palms down on the table and says "Maybe poker is just not your game,...I know let's have a spelling contest" (from the movie *Tombstone*). At the buzzer the shooter picks up the rifle and while seated engages the 4 rifle targets in a progressive sweep starting from the right [1 22 333 4444]. The shooter then moves to the leftmost window, draws a pistol and engages the 5 pistol targets with an outside in sweep from the right two times [2 4 5 3 1]

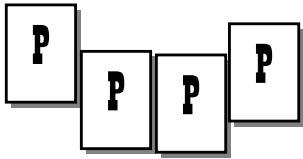

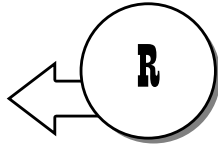
Rifle: 10

Pistols are holstered, rifle in horse's scabbard. **BONUS: Try to rope the steer;** then proceed to the horse placing one hand on the reins and the other on the saddle horn and say "Fill your hands with steel you sons of a bitch" (from the movie *True Grit*). At the buzzer shooter draws the rifle from the scabbard and engages the 5 rifle targets (right side of range) with double tap sweep from the right [11 22 33 44 55]. The shooter then moves to the right most window and engages the 3 pistol targets with 5 shots on 3 targets, two times -shooter's choice as to the order but all 3 must be shot at with each pistol.

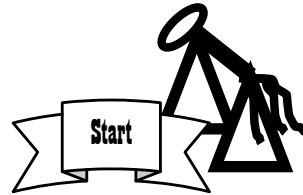
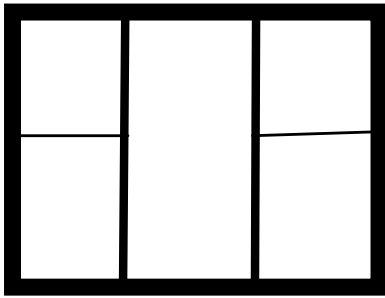

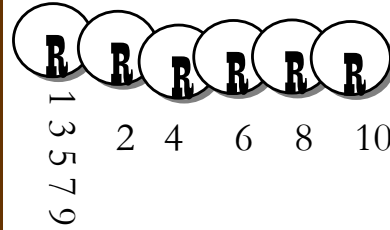

Round Count Pistol: 10 Rifle: 10

With pistols holstered, rifle in rack, horse to the side, shooter says "Buffalo.. It's been a long time since the herd has been this far south." (*She Wore A Yellow Ribbon*) At the buzzer the shooter picks up the rifle and fires 10 shots at the moving Buffalo. The shooter then hands off the rifle and moves to the left engaging the 4 pistol targets through the rightmost window with a 'Cactus Buck' sweep starting with the leftmost target [111 22 33 444]

Round Count Pistol: 10 Rifle: 10

Two pistols holstered, rifle on the table, shooter says " If you pull on me , I'll kill all of you where you stand" (from movie *Appaloosa*) At the buzzer the shooter picks up the rifle and engages the 6 rifle targets with a California sweep—every other shot is at the first target. The shooter then hands off the rifle and moves to the fence where the 4 pistol targets are engaged with a Nevada sweep from the right.

Stage 5



Round Count Pistol: 10 Rifle: 10

While seated at card with rifle on the table pointed down range the shooter turns a card to determine which suit (target) to shoot first. Shooter then says "Isn't that a daisy" (from *Tombstone*) Shooters hands remain palms down on the table and at the buzzer engage the four rifle targets on the left, while seated, in a Nevada sweep starting with the card drawn. Place the rifle back in the rack and move to the pistol circle on the right. Engage the five pistol targets with an inverted Tommy sweep starting with the upper left target. Do the sweep twice.

STAGE CONVENTIONS

These conventions will apply to all shooting stages at the Conestoga Wagoneers shoots. It is the responsibility of each shooter to be familiar with all of these conventions prior to shooting. Any penalties incurred as a result of these conventions will not be grounds for an appeal or re-shoot.

1. All staged guns shall have their barrels pointed safely down range. All rifles that are staged horizontally shall be staged lying flat where at least rear of the trigger guard is on the staging area.
2. Shooters may not start a stage with ammunition in hand.
3. Long guns will be discarded open and empty with their barrels pointed safely down range.
4. Pistols are to be returned to leather after the shooting string, unless otherwise designated in the stage instructions.
5. Pistols are drawn and used in accordance with the shooter's category.
6. Safe gun handling is the shooter's responsibility. The 170° safety rule is in effect.
7. If no starting position is given the shooter shall stand fully erect with revolvers holstered, hands at the shooter's side not touching any firearm.
8. Cowboy port arms is defined as standing fully erect with the butt of the long gun at or below the waist of the shooter, the muzzle at or above the shoulder and the long gun held with both hands.
